SINCE INDONESIA DECLARED INDEPENDENCE ON SEVENTEEN AUGUST NINETEEN FOURTY FIVE, INDONESIA ALREADY HAS THE COMMITMENT TO INVOLVE IN PEACEKEEPING. IT IS STATED IN THE FOURTH PARAGRAPH PREAMBLE OF THE INDONESIA CONSTITUTION 1945 WHICH READS "PARTICIPATE IN IMPLEMENTING WORLD PEACE BASED ON FREEDOM, ETERNAL PEACE, AND SOCIAL JUSTICE"

THE FIRST INDONESIAN PEACEKEEPING MISSION, KNOWN AS INDONESIAN GARUDA CONTINGENT (IGC), COMPRISING 559 MILITARY PERSONNEL, WAS SENT TO EGYPT IN 1957 UNDER THE REIGN OF THE FIRST PRESIDENT OF INDONESIA SOEKARNO. SINCE THEN, INDONESIA HAS CONSISTENTLY PARTICIPATED IN VARIOUS UN MISSION AS WELL AS A NUMBER OF NON-UN PEACEKEEPING MISSIONS AROUND THE WORLD

WITH THE INCREASING INVOLVEMENT OF THE INDONESIA ARMED FORCES (TNI) IN UNITED NATIONS PEACEKEEPING MISSIONS, THERE IS A RECOGNIZED NEED FOR AN INSTITUTION DEDICATED TO MANAGING ALL ASPECTS RELATED TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THESE PEACEKEEPING OPERATIONS. THEREFORE, IN 2007, THE INDONESIA ARMED FORCES PEACEKEEPING CENTER (PMPP TNI) WAS OFFICIALLY ESTABLISHED WITH THE PRIMARY TASK OF PLANNING AND PREPARING TNI PERSONNEL FOR ASSIGNMENTS, TRAINING, AND EDUCATION RELATED TO UNITED NATIONS PEACEKEEPING MISSIONS.

ON DECEMBER 19, 2012, 6th INDONESIA PRESIDENT MR. SUSILO BAMBANG YUDHOYONO INAUGURATED THE NEW PMPP TNI HEAD QUARTER IN SENTUL, BOGOR. IN 2020, PMPP TNI CARRIED OUT ORGANIZATION RESTRUCTURES UNDER THE COMMAND OF A 2-STAR GENERAL.

THE INDONESIA ARMED FORCES PEACEKEEPING CENTER (PMPP TNI) MAIN TASK IS CONDUCT ORGANIZATIONAL & BUDGET PLANNING, OPERATIONAL READINESS, SELECTION, TRAINING, TROOP ROTATION (DEPARTURE/RETURN), PERSONNEL DEVELOPMENT, LOGISTICS OPERATIONS FOR TNI ASSIGNMENT UNITS INCORPORATED IN THE GARUDA CONTINGENT, MILITARY EXPERT ON MISSION, MILITARY STAFF AND OTHER ASSIGNMENTS, AND INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION RELATED TO THE DUTIES OF WORLD PEACEKEEPING OPERATIONS (PKO) IN ORDER TO SUPPORT THE MAIN TASK OF THE INDONESIA ARMED FORCES.

AND THE INDONESIA ARMED FORCES PEACEKEEPING CENTER (PMPP TNI) FUNCTION IS ORGANIZING ACTIVITIES IN THE FIELDS OF PLANNING, SECURITY, TRAINING, OPERATIONS, PERSONNEL, LOGISTICS, AND TERRITORIAL IN ORDER TO SUPPORT THE TASKS OF PMPP TNI.

THE INDONESIA ARMED FORCES PEACEKEEPING CENTER (PMPP TNI) IS LED BY A TWO-STAR GENERAL, ASSISTED BY DEPUTY COMMANDERS AND INSPECTORS, SIX DIRECTORATES, THREE EXECUTIVE ECHELONS, AND TWELVE SERVICE ECHELONS.

OUR VISION IS TO PARTICIPATE AND COLLABORATE TO MAKE THE WORLD PEACE THROUGH PROFESSIONAL PEACEKEEPERS AND OUR MISSION IS TO PREPARE PROFESSIONAL PEACEKEEPERS BY ALL NECESSARY MEANS TOWARDS SUCCESSFUL PEACEKEEPING OPERATIONS WITH THE MOTTO TO WIN THE HEARTS AND MINDS OF THE PEOPLE FOR GLOBAL PEACE

IN 2024, INDONESIA DEPLOYED 2,509 PERSONNEL TO UNITED NATIONS PEACEKEEPING MISSIONS ACROSS SEVEN DIFFERENT OPERATIONS. THESE MISSIONS INCLUDE MONUSCO IN CONGO, UNIFIL IN LEBANON, MINUSCA IN CENTRAL AFRICA, UNISFA IN ABYEI, MINURSO IN WESTERN SAHARA, UNMISS IN SOUTH SUDAN, AND ONE PERSONNEL AS A SECONDMENT OFFICER (SO) AT THE UN HEADQUARTERS NEW YORK. FROM TOTAL OF 2509 PERSONNEL, 134 OF THEM ARE WOMEN.

SINCE 2007, INDONESIA HAS DEPLOYED 940 FEMALE PEACEKEEPERS, AND THE NUMBER CONTINUES TO INCREASE EACH YEAR.

IN 2023, THE INDONESIA ARMED FORCES PEACEKEEPING CENTER (PMPP TNI) CONDUCTED PRE-DEPLOYMENT TRAINING SIX TIMES TO PREPARE PEACEKEEPERS FOR DEPLOYMENT TO UN MISSION AREAS.

IN 2023, THE INDONESIA ARMED FORCES PEACEKEEPING CENTER (PMPP TNI) CONDUCTED 13 UN COURSES, CO-HOSTED BY THE GLOBAL PEACE OPERATIONS INITIATIVE (GPOI), THE UNITED KINGDOM, THE DEFENCE MANAGEMENT TRAINING CENTER (DMTC) CANADA, THE EUROPEAN UNION, JAPAN, BRAZIL, AND AUSTRALIA.

IN 2023, PMPP TNI RECEIVED VISITS OF FRIENDLY COUNTRIES 5 TIMES, FROM THE BRITISH, UN HQ, SINGAPORE, CANADA, AND AUSTRALIA.

THE INDONESIA ARMED FORCES PEACEKEEPING CENTER (PMPP TNI) ALSO CONDUCTED THE GARUDA KOOKABURRA JOINT EXERCISE IN COLLABORATION WITH THE AUSTRALIAN DEFENCE FORCE (ADF) FROM OCTOBER 16 TO 25.

IN 2024, THE INDONESIA ARMED FORCES PEACEKEEPING CENTER (PMPP TNI) WILL CONDUCT 6 PRE-DEPLOYMENT TRAINING WHICH 5 OF THEM ALREADY BEEN CONDUCTED.

IN 2024, THE INDONESIA ARMED FORCES PEACEKEEPING CENTER (PMPP TNI) WILL CONDUCT 10 UN COURSES AND 1 MEETING EVENT, 3 OF UN COURSES HAVE ALREADY BEEN CONDUCTED AND THE NEAREST UN COURSE THAT WILL BE CONDUCTED IS COMPREHENSIVE PROTECTION OF CIVILLIAN COURSE (CPOC) WHICH WILL START FROM 19 TO 23 JUNE.

THE INDONESIA ARMED FORCES PEACEKEEPING CENTER (PMPP TNI) FEATURED PROGRAMS ARE WOMEN PEACEKEEPING TRAINING (WPT) AND UN COMPREHENSIVE PROTECTION OF CIVILLIAN COURSE (CPOC)

WOMEN PEACEKEEPING TRAINING (WPT) IS SPECIALIZED TRAINING PROGRAMS DESIGNED TO PREPARE FEMALE PEACEKEEPERS FOR THEIR ROLES IN PEACEKEEPING MISSIONS. THESE TRAINING SESSIONS AIM TO EQUIP WOMEN WITH THE NECESSARY SKILLS, KNOWLEDGE, AND RESOURCES TO EFFECTIVELY

CONTRIBUTE TO PEACEKEEPING EFFORTS IN CONFLICT ZONES AROUND THE WORLD.

AND UN COMPREHENSIVE PROTECTION OF CIVILLIAN COURSE (CPOC) IS TRAINING PROGRAM DESIGNED TO EDUCATE PERSONNEL INVOLVED IN PEACEKEEPING MISSIONS AND HUMANITARIAN EFFORTS ON HOW TO ENSURE THE SAFETY AND WELL-BEING OF CIVILIANS IN CONFLICT ZONES.

FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE PROTECTION OF CIVILIAN COURSE (CPOC), IN 2023, THE INDONESIA ARMED FORCES PEACEKEEPING CENTER (PMPP TNI) HAS BEEN CERTIFIED BY THE UNITED NATION INTEGRATED TRAINING SERVICE (UN ITS)
